

Title: Tips for Parents Helping their Kids to Learn English

Target: Parents

Abstract of the Movie:

4. Write some simple sentences to describe the photo (See attachment);
5. Audio-tape / video-tape the reading out sentences by your children;
6. Share with friends the audio / video files through social media.



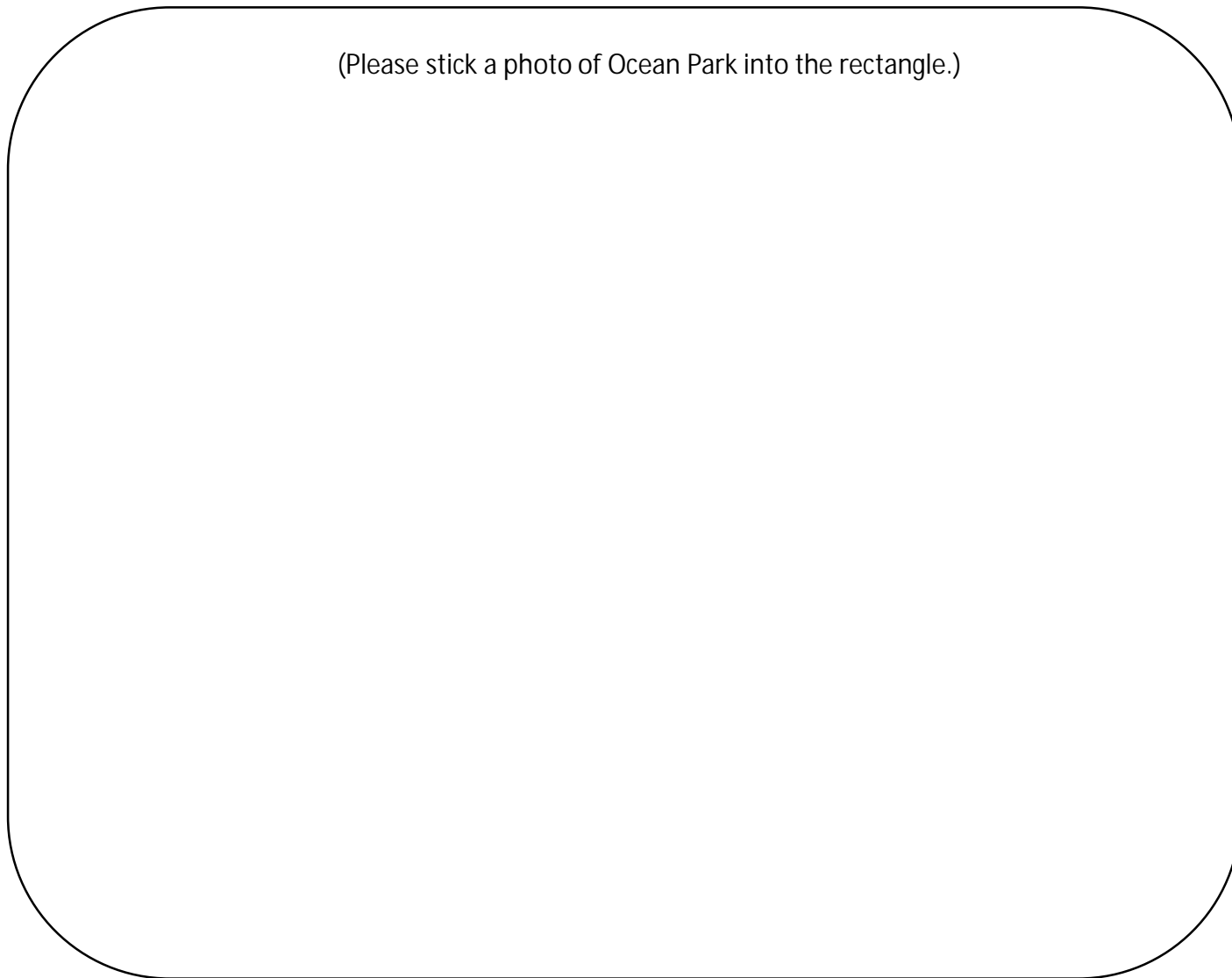
