Abstract of the Movie:

<u>DROPS</u> Request the children match the words with pictures, arrange the phrases to make sentences or make and write the single word in order for learning new words and making applications in their daily lives.		

<p><u>MEMRISE</u> Provide 4 learning modes: Learn new words, classic readers, revision and high-order words through the stories travelling in the universe.</p>
