

**5 - Integrity**  
**Lesson Plan**  
**(Ability level: elementary to pre-intermediate)**

Grade level: Primary 1–2  
Time: approximately 40 minutes

**Suggested Activity 1: Debrief (10 minutes)**

T asks the class a series of clarifying questions about the video, e.g., “How much did Ning Ning get from her mother?”, “How much does Ning Ning usually get?”, “What did Ning Ning buy for \$30?”, “Why did Ning Ning spend the money?” Use the video to refresh students’ memory and pause if necessary.

Allow students 10-15 seconds to discuss the answer before giving the answer in open class. Use the video to refresh students’ memory and pause if necessary.

- Pause the video at “*You must tell the truth, Ning Ning. Now is the time!*” to represent integrity and the lack of it. Have a volunteer read aloud each of the following quotes:

(a) “*Mum, you didn’t give me any money in the morning!*”

(b) “*I am sorry, Mum. By mistake you gave me fifty dollars instead of twenty.*” (from the video)

(c) “*Mum, thanks for the twenty dollars this morning.*”

Ask the class to decide which quote is said by the angel/devil.

- Highlight the meaning of “integrity” (being honest and doing the right thing).

**Suggested Activity 2: Scenarios (25 minutes)**

- Explain that there will be 10 scenarios and 2 quotes for each scenario. Ask the class to decide which quote is said by the angel/devil (by a show of hands).
- Use the PPT to guide students through the questions. Read aloud the questions and the quotes. Clarify the meaning of the words when necessary.
- Students who intentionally choose the “devil” all the time might need to see the teacher after class.

**Suggested Activity 3: Highlights (5 minutes)**

- Refer to **Appendix A**. Write the title and the two sentences on a large (A3/A2) piece of paper. Provide the words/ ask students to look for the words in the video/ use hangman (the guessing game) depending on the language level of students.
- Paste the paper on the classroom as a reminder to the class.

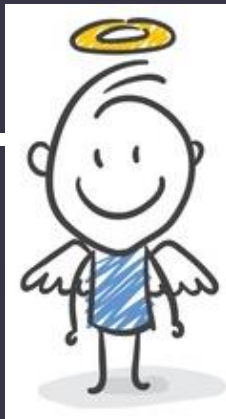
